### Capt. Trey Landry Spring Fishing Report

Inshore: action is heating up with Indian Pass and Apalachicola Bay being the place for Spotted Sea Trout in and around the entire oyster bar habitat, Grass Flats in and around St. George Islands and just outside the endless tidal creek areas of Saint Vincent Island NWR. The Flounder fishing and skinny water back country for Red fishing in and around the same places will produce some great catches of all three species. Redfish will be close to the edges of all tidal creeks and Spartina grass along the backwaters and coastal marsh habitat. Triple Tail, or Sunfish as some call them, are showing also in and around the crab pots as well as all Passes and Buoy Line in and around Apalachicola bay clear around to Saint Joe Bay. Saint Joe Bay area waters are heating up with water temps from 70 to 75 April into May have the Pompano, Flounder, Red Fish, Trout, Jack Crevalle, Spanish Mackerel, Cobia on the move and ready for a meal. Cobia show around the near shore wrecks, the Buoys from Saint Joe Bay ship channel and outside around the Saint Joe Point Gulf waters. Offshore: bites should also start heating up but check with your State and Federal Regulations as they seem to change with the seasons these days. For the most part it's safe to go after the Grouper, Amberjack, Cobia, King Mackerel, Berliners and Black Snapper at this point and the Red Snapper will open June 1st. The offshore trolling action will also wind up around late April till late Summer with Wahoo, Dolphin, and some Billfish will stretching those lucky anglers lines.
