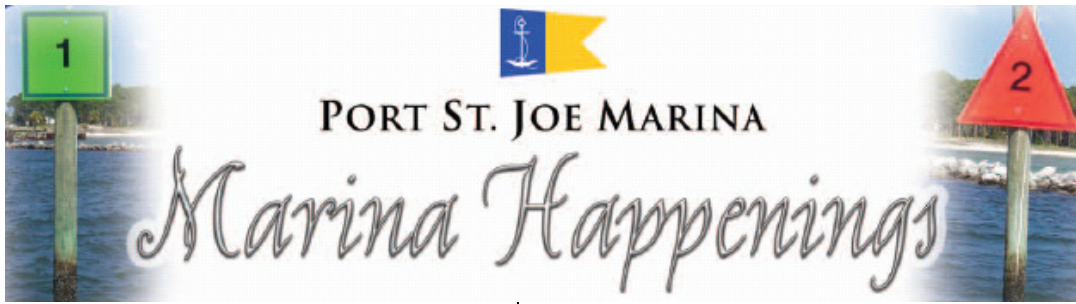

Fishing from the Docks has always been and remains prohibited at Port St. Joe Marina

Bait Traps can only be used in YOUR SLIP. Any fish traps left in open slips or put in slips not belonging to you will be removed at once.

Since the Port St. Joe Marina is now a designated *Clean Marina*,

we all need to do our part in keeping our facilities clean!



Please utilize and SHARE our Fish Cleaning Station.

There will be ZERO tolerance for disposing of fish heads in the marina basin.

If you are using a cast net from the docks, you **MUST** clean up the area after you are done.

Re: Outside Vendors!

If you hire any outside vendor, to work on your boat on the premises, the marina office **MUST** have the Vendor's Liability Insurance on file.

There is also a Vendor fee of \$25 per week, \$50 per month, \$100 per quarter, or \$300 a year. Each time a vendor works on your boat, they must sign in at the Marina Counter.

If we see a vendor working on your boat and we do not have the right paperwork or record of them allowed on the premises, you will be liable for the vendor fees.

New Lights will be installed on docks in March/April

Finger piers at the end of North Dock will be removed in March/April. We are adding in another Lay-Along to the North dock, South Side.
